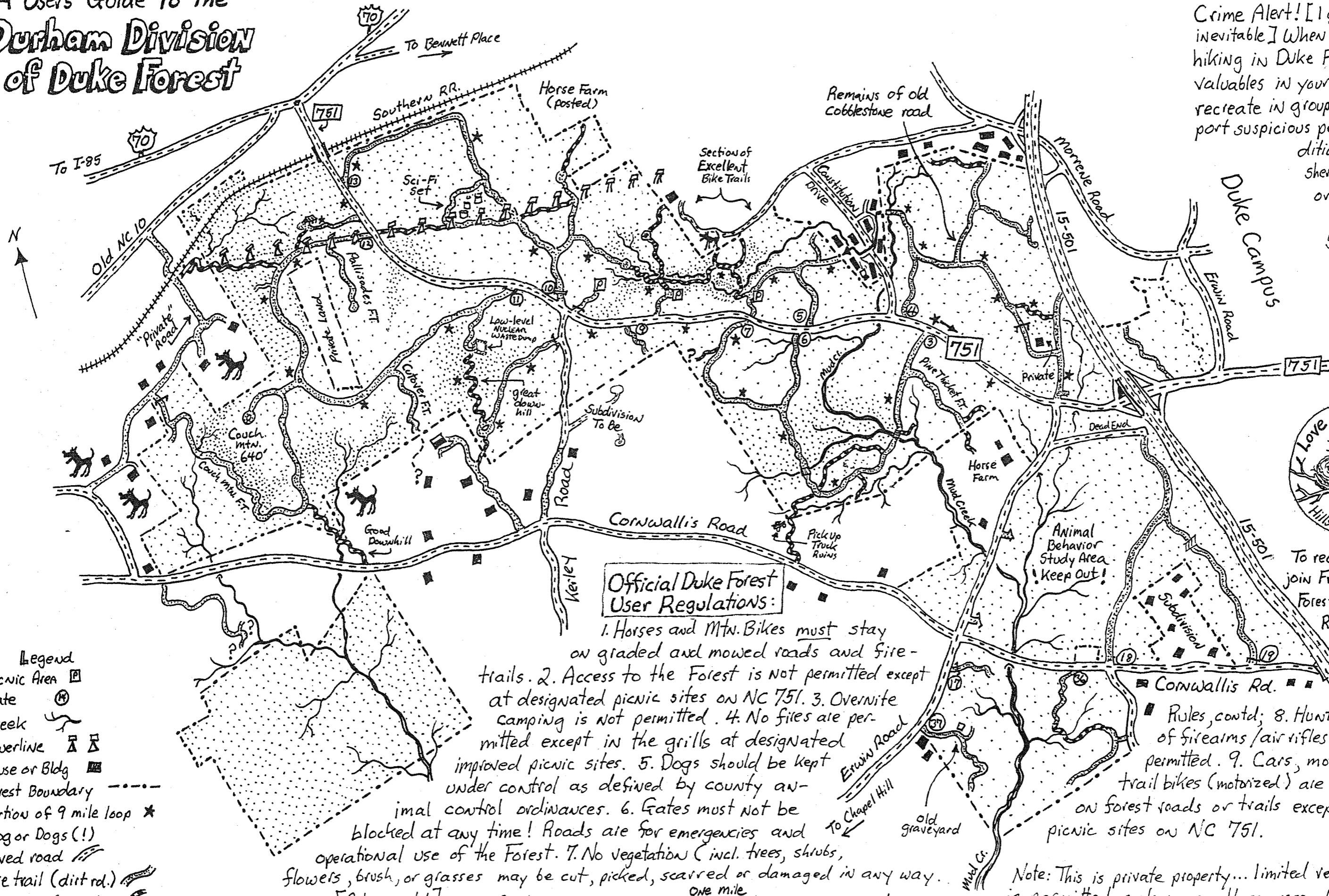


A User's Guide to the Durham Division of Duke Forest

Crime Alert! [I guess it was inevitable] When riding or hiking in Duke Forest, lock valuables in your trunk, recreate in groups and report suspicious persons/conditions to the sheriff's department or Duke Public Safety! Stay out of the Forest dusk to dawn.

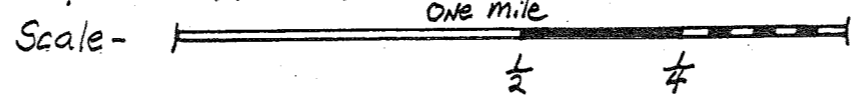


- Legend**

Official Duke Forest User Regulations:

1. Horses and Mtn. Bikes must stay on graded and mowed roads and fire-trails. 2. Access to the Forest is not permitted except at designated picnic sites on NC 751. 3. Overnight camping is not permitted. 4. No fires are permitted except in the grills at designated improved picnic sites. 5. Dogs should be kept under control as defined by county animal control ordinances. 6. Gates must not be blocked at any time! Roads are for emergencies and operational use of the Forest. 7. No vegetation (incl. trees, shrubs, flowers, brush, or grasses) may be cut, picked, scarred or damaged in any way.

Rules, contd; 8. Hunting or shooting of firearms/air rifles is not permitted. 9. Cars, motorcycles, and trail bikes (motorized) are not allowed on forest roads or trails except at designated picnic sites on NC 751.

Note: This is private property... limited recreational use is permitted so long as those uses do not conflict with teaching and research projects.
